

SURPLUS PROPERTY SAMPLE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the \_\_\_\_\_ Board of Education is charged with managing the financial resources of \_\_\_\_\_ school district; and

WHEREAS, the Board must dispose of surplus property within ninety (90) days of declaring such property as surplus; and

WHEREAS, state law requires school districts to advertise in a newspaper of general circulation prior to selling surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the mandate to advertise in a newspaper of general circulation applies even if the surplus property is being sold through an online auction;

WHEREAS, the Board wants to ensure financial resources are used to the maximum benefit of the district; and

WHEREAS, requiring districts to advertise in a newspaper of general circulation when selling items online is redundant and the funds used for the advertisement could be used for other purposes; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the \_\_\_\_\_ Board of Education urges the General Assembly to allow school districts to sell surplus property in a manner deemed most financially feasible by the Board of Education, which may employ the use of an Internet auction, LEA or public website, public sale advertised through a newspaper of general circulation, or other means.
