TSBA membership entitles your district to become a BuyBoard member for free. Once you sign up for BuyBoard, your district has the ability to make purchases from an approved list of vendors that have gone through a competitive bidding process.

BuyBoard was developed to comply with state laws which require government entities to make purchases from an approved list of vendors who have gone through a competitive bidding process. It gives districts the advantage of leveraging the cooperative's ability to get volume discounts and combines it with the ease of online, web-based shopping and ordering. Purchase everything from pencils to lamps to relocatable classrooms, and everything in between.
